DAY 1 ARRIVAL HELSINKI

Welcome to Helsinki – the capital of Finland! Meet your driver at the airport, transfer to Helsinki city center. Dinner on your own.

DAY 2 HELSINKI - SAVONLINNA (B)

Breakfast at the hotel. At the morning 2h city walk in Helsinki with guide. Check-out from hotel by noon and transfer to Helsinki railway station. Train to Savonlinna, appr. 4h15min, including lunch at train. Arriving to Savonlinna, transfer to the hotel for 2 nights. Free time and dinner on own.

Accommodation example: Sokos Hotel Seurahuone Savonlinna ***+

Original Sokos Hotel Seurahuone at the heart of Savonlinna, is located by Lake Saimaa, next to the Market Square and a stone's throw away from Olavinlinna Castle. Almost every room boasts an unforgettable view over Lake Saimaa. Restaurant Perlina di Castello serves delicious Italian food, and during the summer months, Muikkuterassi offers a menu of seasonal, local Saimaa flavours.

DAY 3 SAVONLINNA (B)

Breakfast at the hotel and check-out. Visit in **Olavinlinna castle** by joing public guided tour or pre-ordered private group tour. **Cruise with a steamboat** around Lake Saimaa (1,5h) and have a own cost snack and beverage on board. Afternoon/evening accessible **Seal Safari** (3h). A private seal safari on the home waters of osprey and the endangered Saimaa ringed seal. On this private safari you will enter deep into the national park, to the home waters of osprey and the endangered Saimaa ringed seal. On this tour our main goal is to have good look at the seals and get to know about their life! You will be guided by one of our wilderness guides specialized in seals. The seal safaris are made with open boats to give the participants the best possibility to spot the seals. We also enjoy a coffee break in the wilderness. The boat is a catamaran with bow visor for easy access. You can entry the boat also with wheelchair! The boat is equipped with life jackets, rain gear, EA kit and binoculars. Included transfers, guided tour, life jackets, rain gear if needed, binoculars, coffee in the wild. Dinner on own, overnight Sokos Hotel Seurahuone.

DAY 4 SAVONLINNA – SAHALAHTI (B+D)

Breakfast at the hotel and check-out. Transfer for the visit in **Kerimäki Church**, which is the biggest wooden church in the world! Transfer time ~30 min/23 km. Tour continues via **Punkaharju**, a unique national landscape with very clear water and beautiful nature. Own cost coffee stop in Punkaharju. The tour continues to the Parikkala, visiting very special **Veijo Rönkkönen Sculpture Garden.** Over the course of almost 50 years, from the early 1960s until his death in 2010, Finnish-born artist Veijo Rönkkönen constructed nearly 500 concrete figures and displayed them on the grounds of the home he'd lived in since birth. The majority of these are human statues performing a variety of activities; one noteworthy sight features a cluster of roughly 200 figures, purportedly self-portraits of the artist, in various yoga poses.

Head to Sahanlahti for check in to the traditional lakeside hotel for 2 nigths in standard rooms. 3-course dinner at their hotel restaurant, famous for its homemade local delicacies.

Accommodation example: Saha Hotel, Sahanlahti Resort ***

Situated by Lake Saimaa, 15 minutes' drive from Puumala, Sahanlahti has a private beach, marina and a lakeside smoke sauna. Guests can enjoy Finnish cuisine made with local ingredients, free WiFi and free private parking. All of Sahanlahti Resort's accommodation options include a TV and private bathroom with shower. The air-conditioned cottages feature a living room with kitchenette. The elegant Restaurant & Bar Koskivahti has a large lake-view terrace. Rantamakasiini Restaurant serves drinks, snacks and light dishes. After playing tennis on Sahanlahti's court, guests can unwind in one of the bookable saunas. Bicycles and ski equipment can be rented on site. Other recreational options include fishing, canoeing and hiking.

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DAY 5 NIINISAARI-RAKOKIVI-PUUMALA DAY TOUR (B+L)

Breakfast at the hotel. Departure to Niinisaari Island. Route is extremely scenic and includes ferry rides. Take part in baking Carelian pies or just eat these local savoury pastries. Lunch at Restaurant Niinipuu. Optinal stop at Puumala lasisuuru glassblowing studio. Afternoon visti Rakokivi geological formation from the ice age and Puumala lakeside town with stunnign rouadways across the lakes. Optional sauna in the evening and option to hire rowing boats independently. Dinner on own. Overnight back to Salanlahti Resort.

DAY 6 SAHANLAHTI – PORVOO (B)

Breakfast at the hotel, check-out. Transfer continues to Porvoo via Imatra and Lappeenranta (~3h15min/285km). Lunch on own en route or in Porvoo.

Arrive in Porvoo - proceed to a guided walk in the idyllic town of Porvoo with its well-preserved wooden houses and picturesque cobble-stoned streets. The city's town plan is from the Middle Ages, the low small houses, picturesque yards and narrow streets form a historically unique wooden town milieu. The symbols of Porvoo - the red warehouses on the riverbanks - tell the story of seafaring and trading. Get familiar with the Old Town of Porvoo and the beautiful medieval cathedral. There will be some free time for a cup of coffee or lunch and a walk in the old town filled with delightful shops and craftsmen's workshops. Check in at Runo Hotel. Dinner on own.

Accommodation example: Hotel Runo ****

The Runo hotel – a setting designed for unforgettable experiences Runo – the Finnish for poem – was founded on a dream to create a luxury hotel experience elevated above everyday life, yet approachable and inviting. Breakfast at the hotel. Transfer to the Helsinki airport.
